Nannie was born at Harper, Kentucky on October 16, 1920. She was the fourth of eight children born to John and Lou Coffey Dingus. She was predeceased by both parents and all of her siblings: Ronald Dingus, Thelma Dingus, Ruby Burton, Bill Dingus, Lena Keaton, Charles "Buster" Dingus and Faye Howard. She was also preceded in death by her son-in-law Steve Measel and granddaughter Joy Brooke Measel.

On January 17, 1945 Nannie was married to Glenmore Collinsworth. After 58 years of marriage, Glenmore passed away on April 18, 2003.
